Principal's Report                | Student Lighthouse New dismissal process and discussion | Don updated the team on how well this year's Student Lighthouse is doing under the guidance of Mrs. Alvarez and Mrs. Fidel. The Student Lighthouse team did a great job of planning and hosting our first in-person Leadership Assembly post pandemic. Our next assembly will be Dec 16 <sup>th</sup> and the Student Lighthouse team will start planning for that next week. Our new dismissal plan was put in place to tighten security on campus and have more control on who is entering the campus at the end of the day. We started in November by monitoring the gate and checking for CurbSmart cards as people entered and transitioned this week closing the campus and dismissing from assigned gates. It has been a big improvement security wise, but we are still working out some of the glitches. Parent feed back has been positive. A concern was brought up that some of the 2 <sup>nd</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> graders are being released from the gate before someone shows their CurbSmart card. Mr. Craig said he will follow up with the upper grade teachers and ILT about this concern. There is a new door with a window that has been met with mixed reviews. Some like it and others have raised concern about outsiders being able to see in. The door was sent to us by the district. Mr. Austria raised a question about whether there are currently cameras pointed towards the parking lot. As of right now, there are not but there is a plan to install more cameras. We are not sure as of right now if those new cameras will be pointed towards the parking lot. At the Trunk or Treat there was a homeless man who came through the parking lot during the event and it |
